MINUTES OF THE 18TH MEETING OF THE STEERING COMMITTEE ON INTEGRATED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON 08.03.2011 AT NIRMAN BHAVAN, DEPARTMENT OF LAND RESOURCES, NEW DELHI

The 18th meeting of the Steering Committee on Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) was held on 08.03.2011 under the chairpersonship of Secretary (LR) in the Committee Room of Department of Land Resources at NBO Building, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi. The list of participants is at Annexure-I.

2. The Joint Secretary welcomed the participants and requested the State representatives from Arunachal Pradesh, Mizoram and Tamil Nadu to present the proposals to the Committee for appraisal.

3. Arunachal Pradesh

- (i) The Joinit Director (Rural Development), Arunachal Pradesh made the presentation on performance of the IWMP projects sanctioned to State during 2009-10 and proposals for 2010-11. An area of 0.91 ha for the year 2010-11 has already been appraised & cleared by the Committee in its 14th meeting held on 01.09.2010. The State has proposed for an additional area of 0.48 lakh ha in the current meeting of the Committee.
- (ii) The committee observed that the presentation made by the State representative did not include the mandatory details like strategy for implementation of works, capacity building plan, livelihood, etc. Hence the Committee recommended the State representative to work out the required details and resubmit the proposal in the prescribed formats in 7 days time. Some photographs of the works carried out under EAP so far may also be included in the presentation. The Joint Director assured that the revised proposal will be submitted in 7 days time. The Committee also observed that the State has incurred an expenditure of Rs. 1.87 crore against the available fund of Rs. 0.91 crore for the purpose of capacity building. Even after exceeding the allocated limits of the funds, the State has underachieved in terms of physical targets under capacity building. The SLNA need to clarify the observations before coming for the fresh presentation for these proposals.

- (iii) Though the DPRs for all the 13 projects sanctioned during 2009-10 have been prepared, the same are yet to be uploaded on the departmental website. The Committee advised the Joint Director to upload the DPRs of these projects on their departmental website and intimate the same to the Department of Land Resources.
- (iv) The CCA, MoRD pointed out that as observed from the ASAs for the ongoing IWDP projects, payments are being made in cash for different items of work in Upper Subansiri District. The Committee advised that all payments should be made through cheques.
- (v) The Committee authorized Secretary (LR), the Chairperson of the Steering Committee, to clear the revised proposal of the SLNA, if the same is found in order and received in 7 days time.

4. Mizoram:

- (i) The Director (RD) cum CEO, SLNA, Mizoram made a presentation before the Steering Committee about the achievements made under IWMP and projects to be taken up during 2010-11. In the proposal, it was requested to appraise & clear an area of 0.66 lakh ha (against a tentative target of 0.65 lakh ha) for the year 2010-11.
- (ii) The Committee observed that the progress of appointment of experts/ staff in the SLNA/ WCDCs was not satisfactory. The Committee advised the State representatives to expedite action in this regard for proper implementation of the programme.
- (iii) From the progress, presented by the State, regarding the projects sanctioned under IWMP during 2009-10, it was observed that lot of construction activities have been undertaken under the EPA. The Secretary (LR) suggested that an inventory of activities taken up under EPA may be prepared and circulated to the States.
- (iv) The CEO, SLNA, informed that DPRs for all 16 projects have been prepared but they are finding it difficult to upload the same in the departmental website due to some technical problems.
- (v) The Committee appraised & cleared 16 projects covering an area of 65,880 ha in 8 Districts of Mizoram for the year 2010-11. The list of projects appraised & cleared is at **Annexure-II**.

5. Tamil Nadu

- (i) The Executive Director & CEO, SLNA, Tamill Nadu Watershed Development Agency, made a presentation on 56 projects, covering 2.71 lakh ha, proposed to be taken up during 2011-12.
- (ii) On the progress made in the IWMP projects sanctioned earlier, the Committee observed that the expenditure made was low and suggested the CEO to expedite actions. The CEO informed that the activities under EPA, capacity building and DPR preparation for the projects sanctioned during 2009-10 have been carried out and DPRs uploaded in the Agency's website. For the projects sanctioned for 2010-11, the CEO informed that the activities under the above items are progressing satisfactorily and the DPRs for the 62 projects sanctioned for 2010-11 would be completed by May 2011.
- (iii) Regarding the pre-Hariyali projects in the State, the State has informed that proposals for completion of all such projects under DPAP and IWDP would be submitted within a week.
- (iv) After detailed discussions, the Committee appraised and cleared the entire area of 2,71,093 ha in 24 Districts (list at **Annexure-II**) proposed by the SLNA.
- 7. The Committee appraised and cleared a total area of 3.37 lakh ha in the States of Mizoram and Tamil Nadu as detailed in Annexure –II.

8. Revision in the area already appraised under IWMP:

A. **Manipur:** For the State of Manipur, the Steering Committee had appraised & cleared 28 projects covering an area of 127626 ha during 2010-11, subject to reworking of area in 5 Districts, as the project sizes were not appropriate. However, after reworking, the SLNA, Manipur sanctioned an area of 128083.98 ha (27 projects). The variation in area ranges between 0.12 to 100 %. As per the Steering Committee's decision dated 16.07.2010, the variation of area more than 10 % in project size is to be placed before the Committee and, variations upto 10 %, the JS (WM) can approve the variation and bring it to the notice of the Steering Committee. JS (WM) has approved the variation in project area in 10 projects covering an area of 50,295 ha ranging between 0.12 to 10%. The matter was placed before the Committee for information.

B. **Rajasthan:** Similar is the case for Rajasthan, wherein Steering Committee had cleared 6 projects in Sikar District, covering an area of 35115 ha. There was a variation of 3.7 % in the extent of 1 project viz. Sikar - IWMP-VI/10-11. JS (WM) has approved the same. The matter was placed before the Committee for information.

The Committee considered the above variations in the project area as per Annexure-III and accorded its approval.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
