

**MINUTES OF THE 23rd MEETING OF THE STEERING COMMITTEE ON
INTEGRATED WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME HELD ON
13.12.2011 AT NIRMAN BHAVAN, DEPARTMENT OF LAND RESOURCES,
NEW DELHI**

The 23rd meeting of the Steering Committee on Integrated Watershed Management Programme (IWMP) was held on 13.12.2011 under the chairmanship of Secretary (LR) in the Committee Room of Department of Land Resources at NBO Building, Nirman Bhavan, New Delhi. The list of participants is at **Annexure-I**.

2. The Joint Secretary (WM) welcomed the participants and requested the State representatives from Jharkhand and Punjab to present the proposals to the Committee for appraisal.

3. JHARKHAND

i. The CEO, SLNA, Jharkhand made a presentation on the progress of ongoing watershed projects of Department of Land Resources in the State of Jharkhand. The State has proposed to take up additional 6 new projects covering a total area of 0.36308 lakh ha during the year 2011-12. In the 19th meeting of the Steering Committee held on 21.06.2011, 19 projects covering 1.00062 lakh ha were appraised and cleared by the Steering Committee. Again in the 21st meeting of the Steering Committee held on 16.09.11, 20 projects covering an area of 1.06051 lakh ha in 12 Districts were appraised and cleared by the Steering Committee. Accordingly part of 1st installment i.e. 6% of the central share cost of the projects has been released by DoLR to SLNA, Jharkhand. Thus the total proposal for 2011-12, including current proposal, is 2.42 lakh ha against the minimum tentative target of 2.43 lakh ha allocated by DoLR.

ii. Regarding the progress in engagement of experts & staff in the dedicated institutions set up at different levels, it was observed that the requisite numbers of staff and experts have not been engaged. Further, it was also observed that at WCDC and WDT levels, a big difference in number of staff to be engaged and number actually engaged. The CEO, SLNA stated that the staff and experts had been engaged, but some of them have left the job. The CEO, Jharkhand assured that the vacancies will be filled up at the earliest.

iii. The Committee was informed that 20 DPRs for projects sanctioned during 2009-10 have already been prepared and these have been uploaded on website www.jharkhand.gov.in. Regarding projects sanctioned in 2010-11, the DPR preparation is under progress, and will be completed by April, 2012 and for the projects sanctioned during 2011-12, the preparation of DPRs will be completed by July, 2012.

iv. Regarding Entry Point Activities (EPAs), the CEO, SLNA informed that the EPAs for the projects sanctioned during 2009-10 have been completed and the works phase in these projects have started and the EPAs are in progress in the projects sanctioned during 2010-11 and 2011-12.

v. The CEO, SLNA informed about the difficulty in getting the WCs registered as societies. On this, the Chairman suggested DoLR to take up the matter with the State Government. During the presentation of activities taken up under EPAs, the Committee suggested to include food processing activities depending upon the local availability of raw material and linking them to SHGs under livelihood promotion activity.

vi. Regarding evaluation of the IWMP projects, the Chairman suggested to prepare an abstract of all the individual microwatershed evaluations to get an overall picture of the projects. He also suggested that the State Level evaluation of the projects should be done by the agencies familiar with the social, political, economic and environmental aspects of the State. For this purpose, Committee suggested that a panel of reputed expert institutes located in the State may be prepared by the SLNA and sent to the DoLR for its approval. One of the institutes from the DoLR approved panel should be assigned the task of State level consolidation of phase-wise evaluation report of IWMP projects.

vii. The Committee advised to expedite project implementation and expenditure. The SLNA may consider engaging external expert agencies for timely completion of the DPRs.

viii. CEO, SLNA was also directed to expedite completion of ongoing pre-IWMP projects by December 2012 and also further requisite documents for non-performing pre-WIMP projects for consideration of formal closure of the projects.

ix. After discussion on the proposals for 2011-12, the Committee appraised and cleared 6 projects covering an area of 0.36308 lakh ha in West Singhbhum District of Jharkhand at unit cost of Rs. 12,000 per ha as proposed by SLNA, Jharkhand. The list of projects appraised & cleared is at Annexure-I.

4. PUNJAB

i. The Chief Conservator of Soils, Punjab informed the Committee that the SLNA has proposed for an area of 0.79 lakh ha in 9 Districts for the year 2011-12 against the target of 0.73 lakh ha in the 20th meeting held on 18.08.11.

a. During the 20th meeting held on 18.08.11, the Committee appraised and cleared 12 projects falling in Kandi area of the State covering a total area of 0.67 lakh ha subject to splitting of project area of Hoshiarpur VII and VIII into manageable sizes and submission of districtwise maps on microwatershed basis.

b. Regarding the projects proposed in non-Kandi areas the Committee had opined that it should be considered only after submission of detailed progress by the State, for the projects sanctioned in non-Kandi areas for the year 2010-11.

ii. The State representative made a presentation on performance of the IWMP projects sanctioned to the State during 2009-10 & 2010-11 and proposals for 2011-12, including the projects already cleared by the Committee subject to conditions as mentioned at (i).(a). above. The State has proposed a total area of 0.96 lakh ha for taking up new projects for the year 2011-12.

iii. It was informed to the Committee that only 7 IWDP projects are currently ongoing in the State and the proposals for release of next installment(s) will be submitted to the DoLR latest by January 2012. The State representative assured to complete all these ongoing projects within the timeline of December 2012, as prescribed by DoLR.

iv. The Committee observed that the engagement of experts/ staff at various level of implementation is satisfactory. However, the expenditure was only about 40 %. The State representatives informed that the expenditure will be expedited at the earliest.

v. The State representative mentioned that the DPRs for 6 projects sanctioned during 2009-10 have been prepared and uploaded on the departmental website <http://dswcpunjab.gov.in>. He further assured that the preparation of DPRs for the 13 projects sanctioned during 2010-11 would be completed by January 2012.

vi. It was further informed that evaluating agencies have been empanelled by SLNA and the evaluation reports would be received by March 2012.

vii. The Committee observed that out of Rs. 11.71 crore made available to the projects sanctioned so far, the expenditure till November 2011 was only Rs. 5.255 crore. The State representative informed that the SLNA could get balance 14 % funds for the projects sanctioned in the year 2009-10 during July 2011 only, as the DPRs prepared for these projects had to be improved.

viii. The State representative also made a presentation on the progress made in respect of projects sanctioned so far in non-Kandi Districts of the State.

ix. The Committee suggested that the SLNA may consider to consult institutes like Central Soil Salinity Research Institute, Karnal for preparation of DPRs for projects falling in non-Kandi Districts like Fazilka where specific interventions for water harvesting are required.

x. On the Districtwise projects for the year 2011-12 proposed by the State, the Committee appraised and cleared all the 21 projects covering a total area of 95,645 ha (list of projects at **Annexure-II**). The State representative was advised to submit detailed progress report of projects sanctioned in non-Kandi areas for the year 2010-11, including activities undertaken and the likely impacts of those activities, to the Department.

5. Change of PIAs in IWMP projects sanctioned for the year 2011-12 in Madhya Pradesh:

i. With the permission of the Chair, the issue of change of PIAs in as many as 47 IWMP projects out of 99 projects sanctioned for the year 2010-11 in Madhya Pradesh was included as an additional agenda in the meeting.

ii. Representative from SLNA, Madhya Pradesh informed that Due to the non-availability of WDTs, inability of the NGOs localized in few Districts to execute the

projects in other Districts, majority of area of the project under forest cover (hence, one PIA changed to Forest Dept.) and non-approval of WDT by the WCDC, (in case of NGO PIA, replaced by another NGO-PIA), change of PIAs for 47 projects have been approved by the SLNA, MP, as indicated below:

iii. The Committee, looking into the change of large no. of PIAs by SLNA, MP suggested that in future due care should be taken while selecting PIAs for projects to ensure timely completion of the projects. The revised list of PIAs for the 99 projects sanctioned for the year is t **Annexure-III**.

6. Apart from the above, the following points also emerged out of deliberations during the meeting:

i. The Chairman suggested to provide hyperlink to websites of SLNA of States on the DoLR website so that other States are able to see various activities undertaken by SLNAs. Accordingly, DoLR should write to all SLNAs to upload various activities undertaken in IWMP projects including EPAs on their website.

ii. The SLNAs should maintain a database of photographs of the watershed works, before/ during/ after the construction/ implementation on a time series, with geo-referencing. The photographs may be labeled clearly mentioning the State, District, name of the projects, name of the Block and village, name of the activity and other details.

iii. During discussion of proposals from SLNA, Jharkhand, it was informed that a series of slogans have been painted on walls for generating awareness on the importance of watershed. On this, the Chairman, suggested to highlight IWMP in these slogans. In addition, the committee also suggested that important components like role and composition of WCs, SHGs& UGs should also be included in the wall writings for publicity. Promotion of awareness on IWMP should be undertaken by involving local radio and TV channels in local language.

7. The list of projects appraised and cleared by the Committee, so far, for the year 2011-12 is at **Annexure-IV**.

8. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks, to the Chair.
