

Dear Sir,

A brief report on important issues that engaged the attention of Department of Land Resources during August 2018 is given below:

1. 8214 watershed development projects were sanctioned during 2009-10 to 2014-15 in 28 States (except Goa) under Integrated Watershed Management Programme and later amalgamated under WDC-PMKSY. Budgetary allocations were/ are not commensurate with the total approved cost of the projects. Till the end of 2016-17 no project had been completed.

In 2017-18, with the adoption of the strategies of (i) optimal utilization of available resources, (ii) convergence and (iii) prioritization, as well as (a) accountability and (b) real-time monitoring, 1208 projects in 14 States were completed.

In 2018-19, up to August'18, a further 269 projects in 05 States were completed.

2. An amount of Rs. 455 crores was released to the States upto August' 18 for watershed development under WDC-PMKSY.

3. Department of Land Resources participated in the Tripartite Portfolio Review Meeting (TPRM) for World Bank organized in Chennai on 23rd – 24th August, 2018.

4. Consultancy Evaluation Committee (CEC) meeting was held on 29.08.2018 under the Chairpersonship of Special Secretary (LR) for finalization of the revised Terms of References (TORs) based on the scope of works decision taken earlier for Project Management Consultant (PMC) under Neeranchal World Bank Project.

5. The Second Meeting of Project Steering Committee for 'Land Use Planning and Management Project' being implemented with technical cooperation of Deutsch Gesellschaft fur Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ), Germany was held under the Chairmanship of Secretary (Land Resources) on August 30, 2018 to review the progress of the project. The committee was apprised about the extension of the project till May 31, 2019 and about the revised time line of key outputs of the project as already agreed by the State Governments of Tamil Nadu and Odisha.

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6. There is no case in which ACC directions are pending compliance.
7. Meetings with State Governments / stake holders through video conference were held under the initiatives during the month under Minimum Government, Maximum Governance.
8. The other essential information pertaining to the Department has been furnished in the prescribed format through e-mail at cabinetsy@nic.in and subhag@nic.in.
