Monthly summary of important activities of Department of Land Resources during May, 2022

The Department was awarded *Geospatial World Excellence Award 2022* in Land Administration for Digital India Land Records and Modernization Programme (DILRMP) at the Geospatial World Forum Summit held at Amsterdam, the Netherlands on 12.05.2022.

A meeting was held by the Department with World Bank Officials on 02.05.2022 on Rejuvenating Watershed for Agriculture Resilience through Innovative Development (REWARD) programme. The REWARD project of World Bank was launched by Hon'ble MoRD, Chief Minister of Karnataka and Secretary (LR) on 08.05.2022. Hon'ble MoRD undertook field visit in Tumkur District, Karnataka on 09.05.2022 for assessing progress of works under Watershed Development Programme. He also visited Integrated Farming System and Nursery developed for plantation.

Hon'ble MoRD held a meeting with US/SO/ASO level officers of Department of Land Resources on 12.05.2022 and suggested to give fresh ideas with regard to Vision India 2047, improving the functioning of the Department and better implementation of schemes of the Department.

Representing Department of Land Resources, Joint Secretary (Watershed Management) participated in the 15th Session of Conference of Parties of United Nations Convention to Combat Desertification held at Abidjan, Cote-D-Ivoire from 15th -20th May, 2022, as part of Indian Delegation. JS(WM) highlighted India's achievements on Watershed Development in the COP-15 meeting.

A meeting was held by the Department with the State/UTs on 11.05.2022 regarding Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava and Amrit Sarovar. The Unique Land Parcel Identification Number (ULPIN) has been launched in the State of Punjab.

Under Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), 5577 projects have been completed till date out of the total 6382 projects {8214 (Sanctioned) - 1832 (Transferred to State)}. End line evaluation of 4368 projects has been received till now.

The current status of progress (cumulative) of the different components of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) is as follows:-

- i. Computerization of Land Records of 6,13,621 Villages completed.
- ii. Computerization of Registration 4,885 SROs completed.
- iii. Digitization of 1,13,85,001 Cadastral Maps/FMBs/Tippans completed.
- iv. Integration of 4,012 SROs with land records completed.
- v. Establishment of Modern Records Rooms in 2,707 Tehsils completed.
