Monthly Summary of important activities of Department of Land Resources during November, 2023

- 1. Under the Bhoomi Samvaad series of Meetings initiated by the Department, a Review meeting (Bhoomi Samvad-VII) with North Eastern States and Autonomous District Councils (ADCs) was held under the chairmanship of Secretary (LR) at Vigyan Bhawan Annexe, New Delhi on 24th November, 2023. The Conference was attended by senior officers of State Revenue / Registration Departments, Inspector Generals of Registration from Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Tripura and Sikkim; Chief Executive Officers of ADCs / Secretary to Executive Committee / Executive Secretary of 9 Autonomous Districts Councils (ADCs) of Assam, Mizoram, Meghalaya and Tripura, Senior Officers of Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region and Surveyor General of India, representatives from B.N. Yugandhar Centre for Rural Studies, Lal Bahadur Shastri National Academy of Administration(LBSNAA) Mussoorie. The Conference focused on review of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) and various other initiatives of North-Eastern States/ADCs of North-Eastern States, especially digitization solutions for NE States/ ADCs.
- 2. As part of the Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra launched on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 aimed to raise awareness through outreach activities to achieve saturation of various Government Schemes, Department of Land Resources (DOLR) organized distribution of Abhinandan Patras (Felicitation Certificates) to eligible villages and felicitation of Gram Panchayat GP/ Village level functionaries like Patwari/Lekhpal/Mandal etc. and Gram Panchayat functionaries like Sarpanch for achieving 99 % or above in Digitization of Land Records (as per schedule of Viksit Bharat Sankalp Yatra through the villages) under the Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP). As per the reports received from the States, Abhinandan Patras are being distributed to all Village Panchayats which have achieved saturation in digitization of land records.
- Department organised a webinar under the chairmanship of Secretary (LR) on 'Use of Al-Nibrit for Masking Sensitive data and Block Chain Technology in Registration of Deed/Documents' on 9th November, 2023. State Government officers from Revenue/Registration Departments participated in the webinar.
- Department of Land Resources was conferred the PLATINUM SKOCH AWARD under E-Governance Category for DILRMP in the function held at New Delhi on on 18<sup>th</sup> November, 2023.
- 5. A review meeting was taken by Secretary (LR) with States / SLNAs on Watershed Development programme (WDC-PMKSY 2.0) on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2023. A review meeting on the implementation of REWARD program in States of Karnataka and Odisha was held by the Department during the month.
- The Department participated in the International Conference on "Sustainable Natural Resources Management under Global Climate Change" held from 7<sup>th</sup> -10<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 at NASC Complex, ICAR, Pusa Campus, New Delhi.

- Department of Land Resources organized two Yoga Sessions on 'Stress Management' through a renowned Yoga expert on 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> November, 2023 at Rejuve wellness centre at Shivaji Stadium Office. Officers and staff of the Department participated in the Yoga Sessions.
- 8. On the occasion of **Constitution Day 2023**, a pledge was administered to officers and officials of the Department in all three offices of the Department.
- Under Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), 6376 projects have been completed till date out of the total 6382 projects {8214 (Sanctioned) - 1832 (Transferred to State)}. End line evaluation of 6120 projects has been completed till now.
- The current status of progress (cumulative) of the different components of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) is as follows:
  - i. Computerization of Land Records of 6,24,391 Villages completed.
- ii. Computerization of Registration 5,050 SROs completed.
- iii. Digitization of 1,93,45,505 Cadastral Maps/FMBs/Tippans completed.
- iv. Integration of 4,590 SROs with land records completed.
- v. Establishment of Modern Records Rooms in 3,341 Tehsils completed.
