Monthly summary of important activities of Department of Land Resources during December, 2022.

An International Conference on "Cactus Plantation and its economic usage" was held under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj (RD&PR) on 8th December, 2022 at Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi. Hon'ble MoS (RD and Steel) and Hon'ble MoS (RD and CA&FPD) were present in the meeting. Diplomats from Brazil, Chile, Morocco, Ambassadors of India in Brazil, Chile, Morocco and Mexico (through VC), Secretaries of Land Resources and Rural Development, International Experts on Cactus from various countries and Senior Officers from various Ministries/Departments including MEA participated in the Conference. The objective of the aforesaid Conference was to explore opportunities for fodder, fuel etc. through Cactus Plantation in the Watershed Projects.

2. Hon'ble Minister (RD&PR) reviewed the progress on Cactus project being conceived as pilot at Amlaha, Madhya Pradesh on 20th December, 2022 in the Department. Regional Director, International Centre for Agricultural Research in the Dry Areas (ICARDA) was also present.
3. With respect to National Generic Document Registration System(NGDRS), Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal and NCT Delhi have started sharing data related to registration of documents with national portal of NGDRS raising the total number of NGDRS and NGDRS linked States /UTs to 20. Thus the States that have onboarded NGDRS include: Punjab, Andaman & Nicobar, Manipur, Goa, Jharkhand, Mizoram, Himachal Pradesh, Maharashtra, Dadar and Nagar Haveli, Jammu and Kashmir, Chhattisgarh, Tripura, Ladakh, Bihar, Assam, Meghalaya, Uttarakhand, Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal and NCT Delhi.
4. Unique Land Parcel Identification Number (ULPIN) has been rolled out in Kerala making the total number of ULPIN rolled out States / UTs to 25. Thus, the ULPIN rolled out States/UTs include: Andhra Pradesh, Jharkhand, Goa, Bihar, Odisha, Sikkim, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Rajasthan, Haryana, Tripura, Chhattisgarh, Jammu & Kashmir, Assam, Madhya Pradesh, Nagaland, Mizoram, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, Dadra & Nagar Haveli and Daman & Diu, Himachal Pradesh, West Bengal, Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand and Kerala. Pilot testing of ULPIN has been done in 7 more States /UTs viz. Karnataka, Puducherry, Andaman & Nicobar, Manipur, Delhi, Telangana and Ladakh.
5. Department of Land Resources conducted 3rd National Review meeting on Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme "भूमि SAMVAAD" on 6th December, 2022 under the Chairmanship of Secretary(LR) to assess the progress made by States/UTs regarding the implementation of the scheme at national level. Senior officers from States/UTs participated in the National Workshop. Select States presented their best practices adopted in DILRMP during the meeting.

6. A meeting was held on 9th December, 2022 with National Rainfed Area Authority to review the development of the World Bank assisted REWARD programme by Joint Secretary (WM), DoLR.

7. Under Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), 6372 projects have been completed till date out of the total 6382 {8214 (Sanctioned) - 1832 (Transferred to State)}. End line evaluation of 5672 projects has been received till now.

8. The current status of progress (cumulative) of the different components of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) is as follows:-

- i. Computerization of Land Records of 6,20,767 Villages completed.
- ii. Computerization of Registration 4,905 SROs completed.
- iii. Digitization of 1,18,71,791 Cadastral Maps/FMBs/Tippans completed.
- iv. Integration of Revenue and Registration 4,043 SROs with land records completed.
- v. Establishment of Modern Records Rooms in 2,841 Tehsils completed.
