Monthly summary of important activities of Department of Land Resources during July, 2022.

The Department successfully organized the National Watershed Conference on 14.07.2022 under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Rural Development and Panchayati Raj. Hon'ble MoS, MoRD Shri Faggan Singh Kulaste, Hon'ble MoS, MORD Ms. Sadhvi Niranjana Jyoti, Hon'ble MoS, MoPR, Shri Kapil M. Patil were also present in the said Conference. Approximately 700 participants from all over the country attended the Conference. Eminent Guest Speakers like Padma Shri Awardees Shri Popatrao Pawar (Hiware Bazar, Maharashtra), Shri Jadav Payeng (Forest Man of India, Assam) and Shri BMS Rathore (former Chief Policy Adviser ICIMOD) contributed immensely to the deliberations. The way forward after achieving/covering 27 million hectare in Watershed Development was deliberated prominently.

2. Third meeting of Steering Committee on WDC-PMKSY 2.0 was held on 26.07.2022 under the Chairmanship of Secretary, DoLR. The proposals of 11 new projects for the UT of Ladakh under WDC-PMKSY 2.0 were appraised and sanctioned by the Committee.
3. National Generic Document Registration System (NGDRS) was rolled out in Meghalaya on 13th July, 2022.
4. A Workshop on Indian Language Transliteration Solutions was held from 27 July to 29 July, 2022 at C-DAC, Pune. It was attended by Chattisgarh, Tamil Nadu, Puducherry, Bihar, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and NIC-DoLR.
5. A review meeting on PFMS related matter was held under the chairmanship of Additional Secretary, DoLR on 08.07.2022.
6. Joint Secretary (Watershed Management), DoLR visited Mamit District as CPO and CNO for JSA-CTR (Jal Shakti Abhiyan – Catch the Rain) from 02.07.2022 to 06.07.2022.
7. Under Watershed Development Component of the Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (WDC-PMKSY), 5924 projects have been completed till date out of the total 6382 {8214 (Sanctioned) - 1832 (Transferred to State)}. End line evaluation of 5159 project has been received till now.

8. The current status of progress (cumulative) of the different components of Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP) is as follows:-

- i. Computerization of Land Records of 6,15,333 Villages completed.
- ii. Computerization of Registration 4,892 SROs completed.
- iii. Digitization of 1,14,87,407 Cadastral Maps/FMBs/Tippans completed.
- iv. Integration of 3,970 SROs with land records completed.
- v. Establishment of Modern Records Rooms in 2,778 Tehsils completed.
